The title should be comprehensive but concise. Limited to ~ 100 characters

Note: the title can be tentative and can be modified (but not changed completely) according to the progress of research

The title should be followed by the name and affiliation of the student and the name of supervisor(s)

### **Abstract**

An abstract of the proposed research of 250 words or less is required. The abstract should be informative to scientists in the same or related fields. A statement of the project's potential contribution to the research done in that field should be include

#### Research Plan

Required information:

- 1. A brief description of the subject and the scientific and technological background;
- 2. Objectives and significance of the research;
- 3. Comprehensive description of the methodology and plan of operation
- 4. Preliminary results (if already obtained)
- 5. Risk analysis and alternative paths that will be followed if the suggested research plan fails
- 6. An account of available resources, including personnel and equipment relevant to the research
- 7. Time Schedule (can be tentative)

#### References

The reference format should follow the following lines

- Names of all co-authors, including first name or initials. In group publications, those
  with more than four authors, specify the names of the first three authors followed
  by the abbreviations such as et al
- Year of publication
- Full title of article
- Full name of journal (or its standard abbreviation, i.e. *J Chem Phys*)
- Page numbers

# Although we do not limit the length of the proposal we recommend that it should not exceed 10 pages
